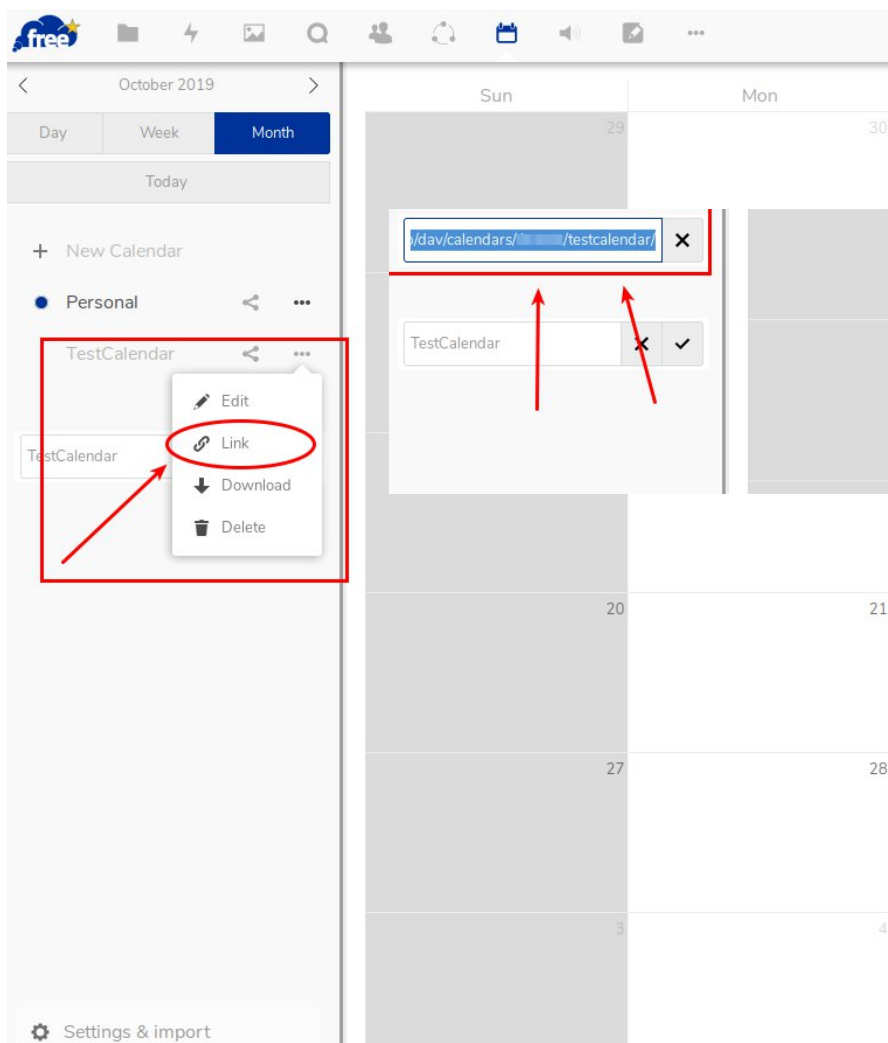


## Setting up Thunderbird (Linux/Windows/MacOS)

### Step 1:

#### Finding the "Location Link" in your freecloud.eu account

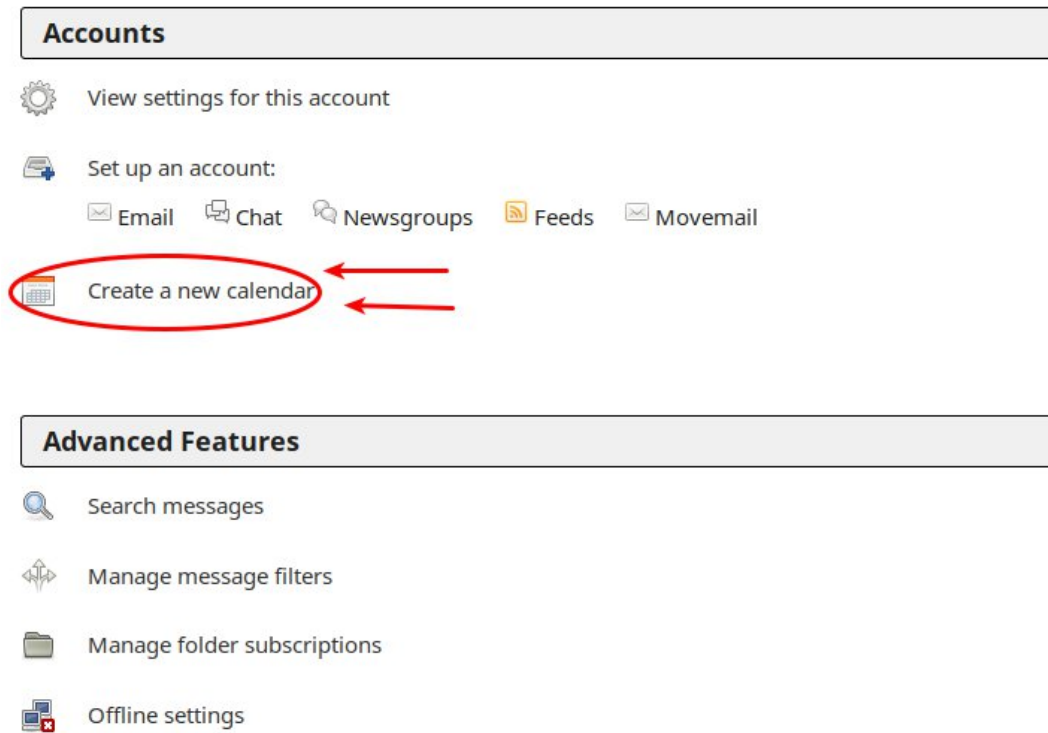
1. Go to <https://freecloud.eu/apps/calendar/>.
2. Click at the three points "..." of your preferred calendar, that you want to synchronize with your client.
3. Click on Link and freecloud will show you the Location Link that you need to copy for your client.



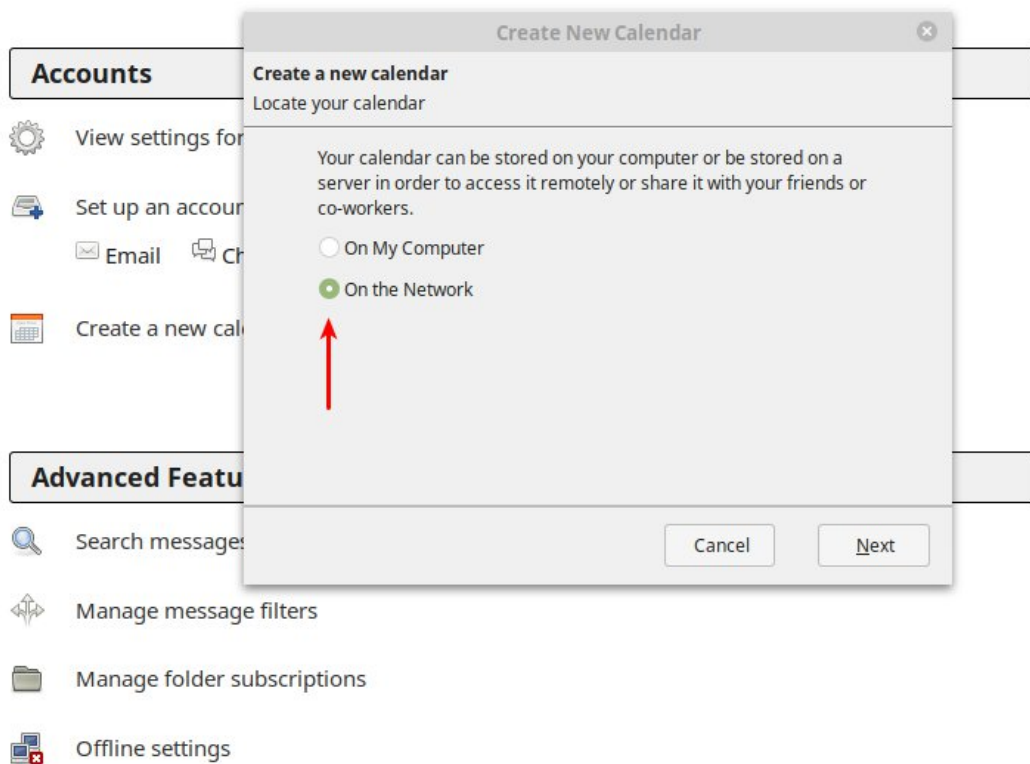
## Step 2:

### Setting up Mozilla Thunderbird

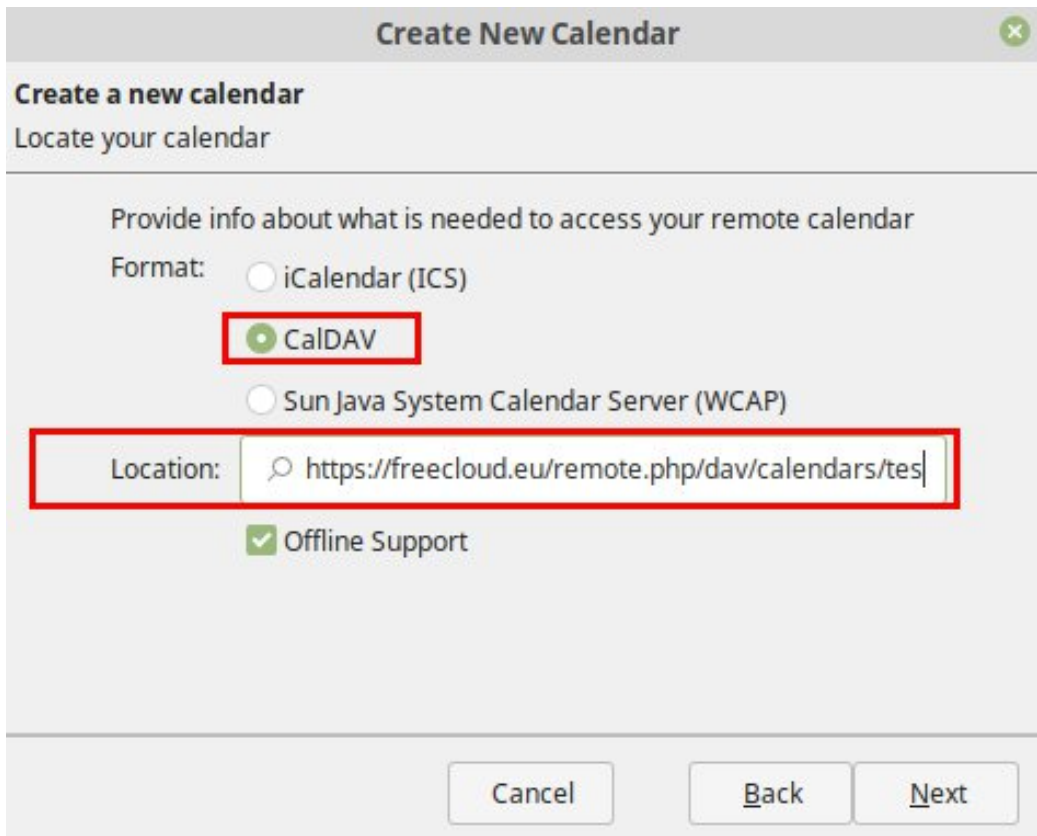
After finishing the installation start Thunderbird and click at "Create a new calendar" to create a new calendar.



Now choose "On the Network" and press "Next" in the bottom right corner to proceed.



Now we can paste the Location-Link into the "Location", after choosing to use the CalDAV protocol as showed in the screenshots below.



Finally enter a nickname for your calendar and a color for your specific calendar. If you want to store invitations from other people in your calendar, you can assign an E-Mail identity by choosing one of the E-Mail-Accounts from the Dropdown menu.
